Christina M. Gerety v. Atlantic City Hilton Casino Resort

On January 18, 2005 at 11:30 a.m., the New Jersey Supreme Court will hear oral argument in *Christina M. Gerety v. Atlantic City Hilton Casino Resort*. This important employment discrimination case involves the validity of provisions of a leave of absence policy that are commonly used by employers in New Jersey. Proskauer Rose LLP represents an *amicus* party on this appeal, the Employers Association of New Jersey ("EANJ"), and will be presenting oral argument in the case. The argument will be simulcast live, via a streaming webcast, at http://www.judiciary.state.nj.us/webcast/index.htm.

The case centers on an employer's ability to implement and apply facially-neutral and nondiscriminatory benefits policies that track or exceed employee benefits guaranteed by federal and state law. Like the majority of employers in New Jersey, Hilton's leave of absence policy offered eligible employees 26 weeks of leave time — more than twice the amount mandated by either federal or state law alone. Nonetheless, the trial court ruled that Hilton's policy was discriminatory on its face because it did not favor female employees with pregnancy-related illnesses. Proskauer and the EANJ have argued that the trial court unduly expanded New Jersey's Law Against Discrimination and contradicted the intent of federal and state employee benefits laws governing leaves of absence.
