

## Maryland Employers Be Aware: Effective Today Maryland's State-Wide Minimum Wage Increases to \$8.75 Per Hour And Montgomery County Increases Its Minimum Wage To \$10.75 Per Hour

Today, the statewide minimum wage in Maryland <u>increased</u> from \$8.25 per hour **to \$8.75 per hour**. This represents a regularly-scheduled increase as part of the Maryland Minimum Wage Act of 2014 (the "Act"), which will increase the minimum wage in Maryland from \$7.25 to \$10.10 per hour by July 2018. The next scheduled increase under the Act will occur on July 1, 2017 when the minimum wage will increase to \$9.25 per hour... Continue Reading
