

Seventh Circuit Issues Ruling Interpreting False Claim Act Whistleblower Amendments

The Seventh Circuit recently issued a <u>decision</u> interpreting the anti-retaliation provisions 7th circf the False Claims Act (FCA). The decision provides important clarifications about how courts may interpret recent amendments to this provision. Like a recent decision by the <u>Fourth Circuit</u>, the Seventh Circuit finds that courts may inquire whether the employee's underlying complaint of FCA fraud was objectively and subjectively reasonable.
