

# Proskauer Launches FutureReady, a Global Initiative to Prepare Communities for the Future of Work

**BOSTON, July 8, 2026** – Proskauer today announced the launch of FutureReady, a multi-year commitment focused on helping communities prepare for the future of work.

The launch took place at a breakfast event hosted by Proskauer's Boston office in partnership with [Sport dans la Ville](#), a leading nonprofit organization that uses sport as a pathway to youth development, social inclusion, and future employment. The event was held as part of [Festival 26](#), an international youth festival co-organized by Sport dans la Ville and Boston SCORES that brings together 400 young people from 24 countries for cultural exchange, leadership development, and a fair play soccer tournament in conjunction with the 2026 FIFA World Cup.

FutureReady is the newest initiative for Proskauer Impact, the firm's platform for community engagement, pro bono, volunteerism, charitable giving, and strategic partnerships.
