

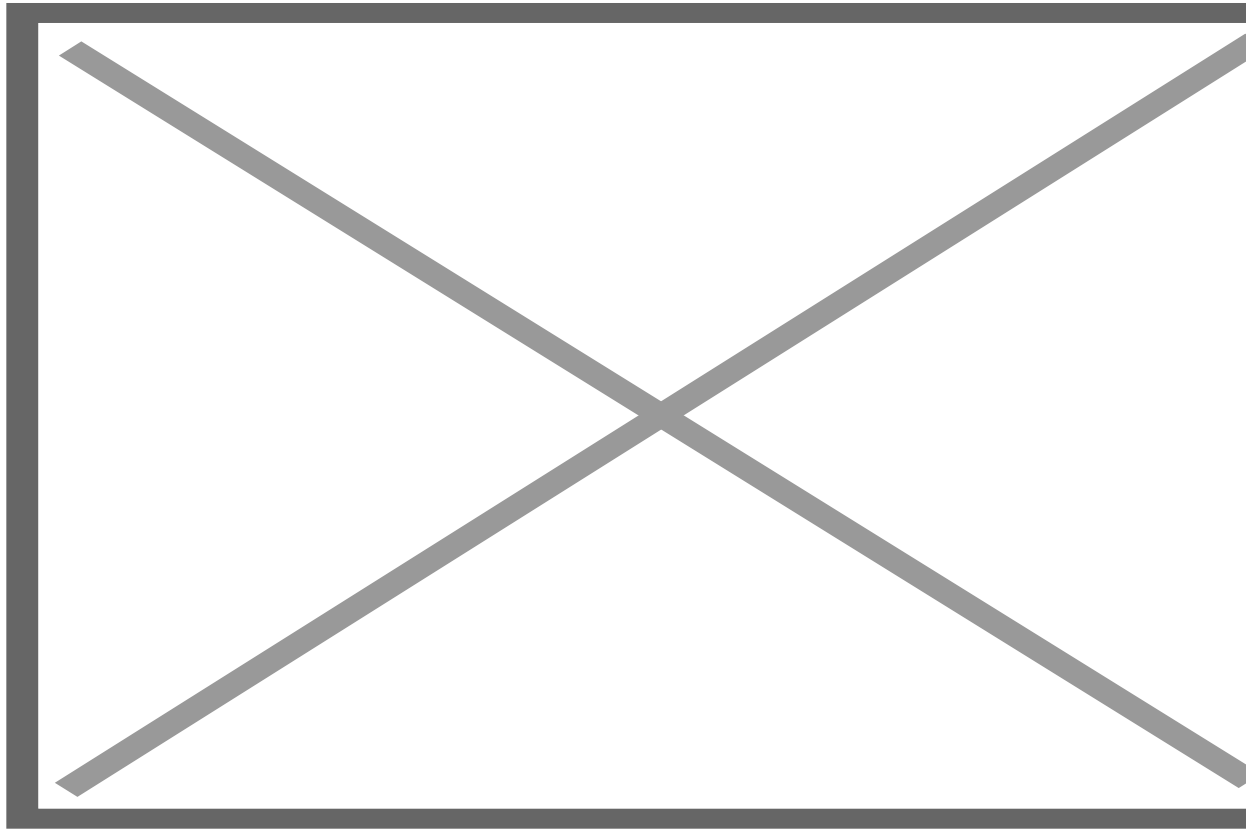
## Connection Across Borders at the Bayeux Tapestry Exhibition

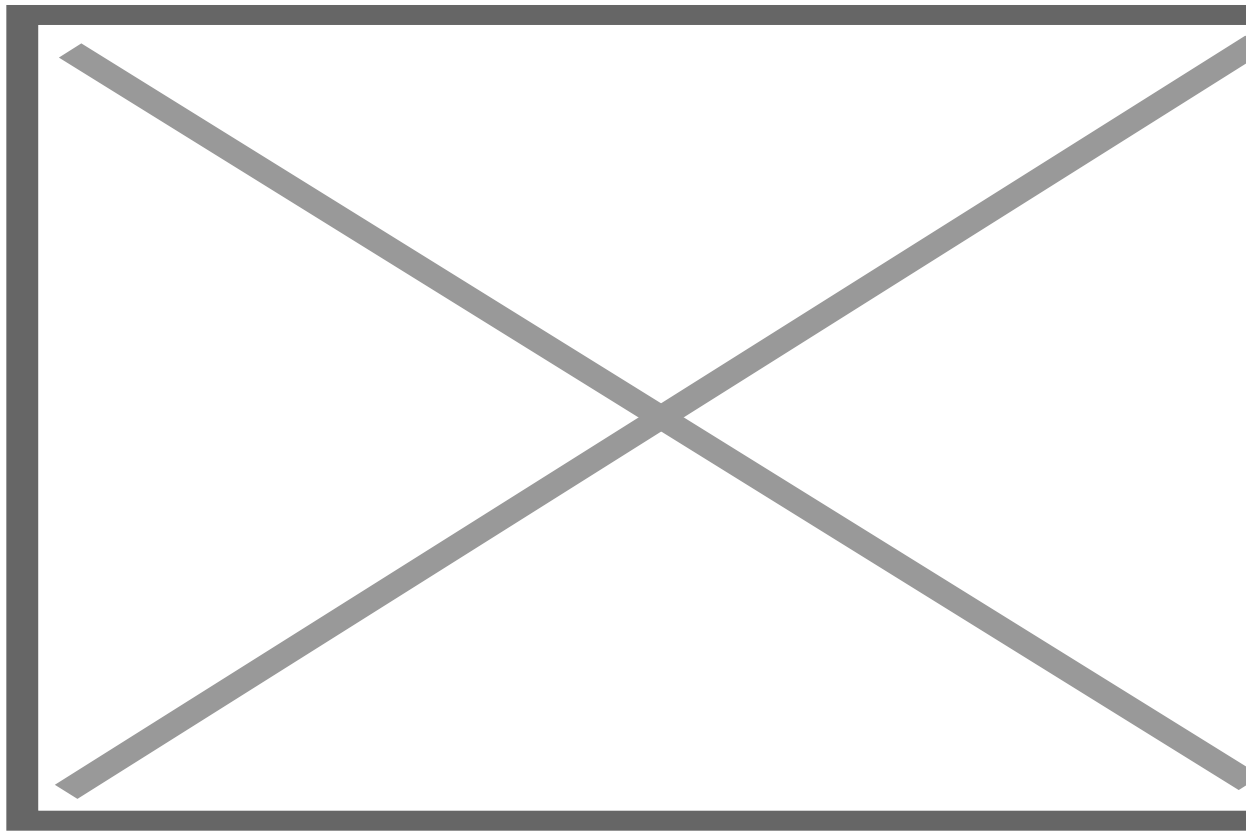

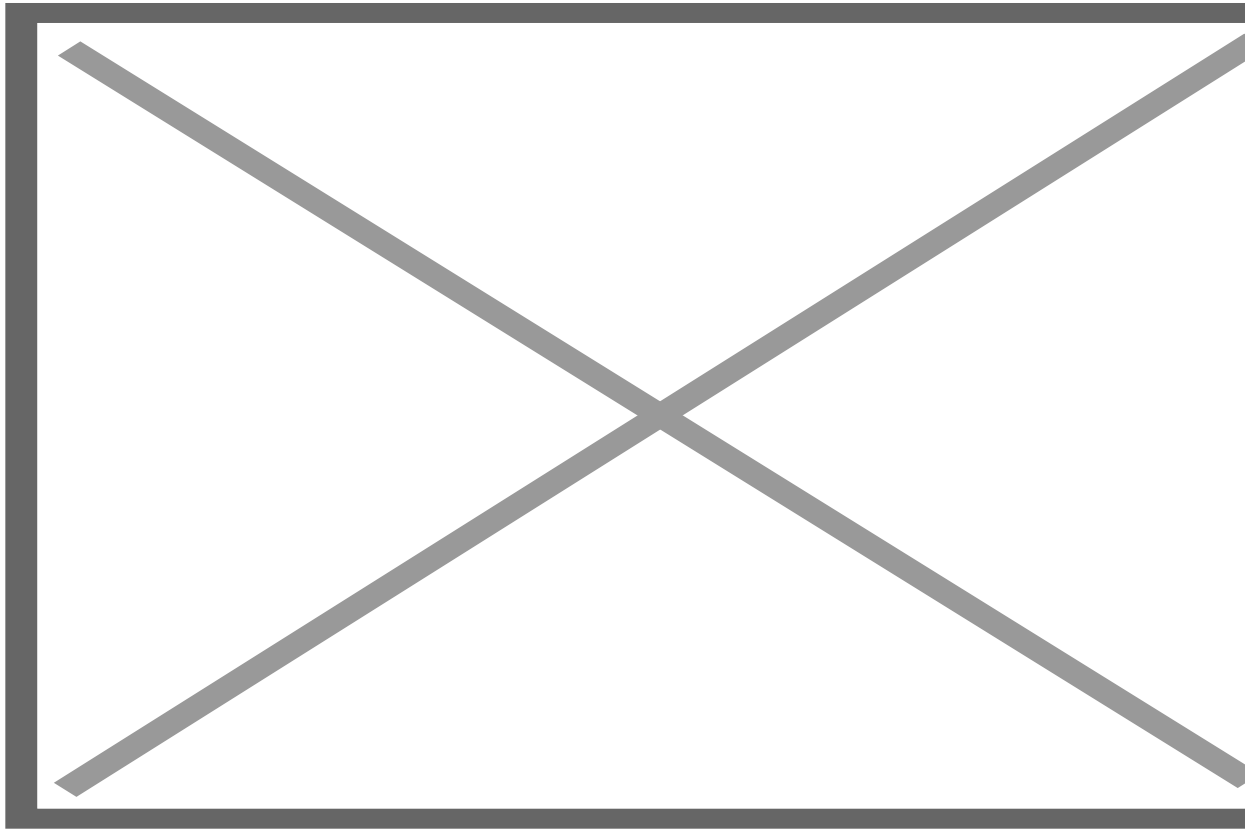
