The Firm: Proskauer Rose has occupied a position close to the apogee of the US sports law market for many years. Commentators view its grip on the pinnacle as likely to strengthen yet further after another astonishing year of sporting success. The team represented the NBA in its collective bargaining agreement with the NBAPA, and served as labor counsel to the NFL during its collective bargaining agreement with its player association. The team remains lead counsel to the English Premier League in an ongoing suit against YouTube concerning the presence of copyright-infringing content on its website.

Sources Say: "The lawyers have great people skills, and take a very collaborative approach - it's not about doing things their way, but about working with us to make sure we're doing it in the right way for us."
