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Konstantinos (Kos) Vavelidis is a partner in the London office of Proskauer. He advises on the EU and UK regulatory framework, including risk retention and transparency requirements, as they apply to European and U.S. transactions and retention financing arrangements. Kos has been at the forefront of developments in the European CLO market, including the development and negotiation of uptier priming debt provisions, ESG-related disclosure and investment language, rating agency criteria, sanctions provisions and other bespoke structural and commercial concepts.

He also has extensive experience in derivatives and repo transactions, and has acted for banks, hedge funds, private equity sponsors, corporate borrowers, sovereigns and sovereign wealth funds on a broad range of cross-border OTC and structured derivatives transactions involving currencies, rates, commodities and credit products.

Before joining Proskauer, Kos was a partner at a global US firm based in New York and previously London, and worked at other major law firms and was seconded to the structured finance team at Barclays and twice to the International Swaps and Derivatives Association.
