Mass Transit

Use mass transit to make your trip to the US Open convenient and cost-effective.

The US Open is held at:

USTA Billie Jean King
National Tennis Center
Flushing Meadows Corona Park,
Flushing, NY 11368

Subway: The 7 train provides easy service from Grand Central Terminal to Mets-Willets Point Station, including connections for all Metro-North trains from Westchester and Connecticut. Service is also available from the Port Authority Bus Terminal.

Long Island Rail Road: LIRR provides easy service to Mets-Willets Point Station from Woodside and convenient connections from Penn Station for New Jersey Transit customers.

For guests with disabilities, get off the LIRR train at 61st/Woodside Station and transfer to the 7 train. Take the 7 train to Mets-Willets Point Station.

MTA Schedules: The [MTA website](#) provides complete schedules and information about the most convenient ways to get to the US Open.

Rideshare: All non-preferred service providers, including black-car services and other ride shares (i.e., Uber, Lyft, etc.), will only have access to the area next to the New York State Pavilion. There is a direct walking path between the New York State Pavilion and the South Gate. A complementary shuttle will be provided.

Driving to the US Open

To save time, we recommend you use either the Van Wyck Expressway and Exit 12A—College Point Blvd or the Long Island Expressway (LIE/I-495) and Exit 22B—College Point Blvd. From there, you will be directed by NYPD to the parking areas.

Paid Parking: Public parking is available at Citi Field and the South Field Lot for \$40 (with the exception of the dates when the New York Mets are playing at home). During the conflict dates, public parking will relocate to various lots throughout Flushing Meadows-Corona Park. These are numbered as lots 1-7.

Traffic Alert: Due to schedule conflicts with the Mets and anticipated traffic conditions, we strongly recommend that all US Open attendees utilize public transportation on the specified dates listed below.

Policies & Procedures

Security Procedures: Safety is one of the highest priorities at the US Open as we continue to take every reasonable step to ensure the safety of everyone entering through the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center gates. Once again, several important security measures will be implemented in conjunction with local, state and federal law enforcement agencies.

1. We encourage you to arrive early to avoid delays and help speed the entry of all spectators.
2. All fans will go through a screening process before passing through the USTA Billie Jean King National Tennis Center entry gates.
3. There will be a limit of one bag per guest admitted onto the grounds.
4. All bags are subject to search and cannot be larger than 12"W x 12"H x 16"L.
5. There will be no bag storage on the grounds. For a nominal charge, there are bag storage facilities located outside the East Gate and South Gate entrances.
6. Speed Lines for guests without bags will be available at all gates.

Prohibited Items

The following items are prohibited and MAY NOT be brought onto the premises:

Backpacks

(except single-compartment drawstring bags)

Hard coolers or like containers

Sealed packages of any kind

Bottles or cans

(glass or metal)

Aerosol cans or noisemaking devices

Alcohol

Video cameras or recording devices

(except for cellphones and SLR cameras with video or recording capabilities)

Computers or laptops

Weapons

(regardless of permit)

Animals

(unless a service animal)

Flags, banners or signs

Any materials constituting unauthorized advertising or promotion

Laser-pointing devices

Tennis racquets

Drones

(UAS-Unmanned Aircraft Systems or other model aircraft)

“Selfie” sticks or other telescopic devices

Any other items deemed inappropriate or dangerous by the US Open personnel, in their sole discretion.



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
